WHAT YOU CAN DO



- Learn to identify and report invasive species that threaten your area
- Use artificial bait as a safe alternative to live or dead bait
- Always check the regulations in your region before using or moving live bait
- Dispose of your unused bait and bait water in the garbage at least 30m from the shore
- Never transfer live fish from one water body to another
- Clean Drain Dry your fishing equipment and boat once you leave the water.
