

## MOSS BALL DISPOSAL

and Aquarium Decontamination After Zebra Mussel Exposure



- Treat Moss Ball
  - Freeze moss ball in resealable plastic bag for at least 24 hours
  - Place moss ball in boiling water for at least one minute
  - Dispose of water down household drain
- Dispose of Moss Ball
  - Place moss ball and any packaging in sealed plastic bag
  - Dispose of in garbage (NOT compost!)

## 3 Decontaminate Aquarium

without plants/animals)
and potassium chloride
treatment (for tanks with
plants/animals)

 Only(!) treated water can be disposed of down household drain
