



MOSS BALL DISPOSAL

and Aquarium Decontamination After
Zebra Mussel Exposure



1

Treat Moss Ball

- Freeze moss ball in resealable plastic bag for at least 24 hours
- Place moss ball in boiling water for at least one minute
- Dispose of water down household drain

2

Dispose of Moss Ball

- Place moss ball and any packaging in sealed plastic bag
- Dispose of in garbage (**NOT** compost!)

Decontaminate Aquarium



- Scan the QR code for detailed instructions on heat treatment (for tanks without plants/animals) and potassium chloride treatment (for tanks with plants/animals)
- Only(!) treated water can be disposed of down household drain
